The Board of Directors of the Fair Lakes League acknowledges the strong support that Fair Lakes residents and employees give to our community. In recognition of this continued support, the Fair Lakes League will award five (5) \$1,000 scholarships to employees and/or residents of Fair Lakes as well as their dependents.

Prospective applicants must read the guidelines and procedures found on page 2 and provide the necessary information on the appropriate application form found on pages 3-5. Applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee of the Fair Lakes League Board of Directors. Winners will receive notification the week of June 23rd. A reception to honor the recipients and award the scholarships will be held in July at the Fair Lakes League office. All applicants will be notified of their outcome.

IMPORTANT

- 1. Applicants not submitting a complete application packet will not be considered (see Application Procedures on page 2).**
- 2. Handwritten applications and essays will not be considered.**
- 3. Those holding the following positions within the Fair Lakes League, as well as their dependents are ineligible to apply for the Fair Lakes Scholarship: Board members, Executive Director, Marketing Coordinator, Property Manager.**

Eligibility Guidelines

Employee Scholarship - An applicant must:

1. Be a full or part-time employee of a company located within Fair Lakes. If the company has several different locations, the employee must work full or part-time at the company's Fair Lakes office.
2. Be pursuing an undergraduate degree or graduate degree.
3. Be currently enrolled or able to verify acceptance at an educational institution.
4. Have a minimum academic standing of 3.2 cumulative GPA (4.0 scale) or greater (this applies to current students only).

Resident Scholarship - An applicant must:

1. Be a current resident of any Fair Lakes neighborhood. These neighborhoods include:

2. Be pursuing an undergraduate degree or graduate degree.
3. Be currently enrolled or able to verify acceptance at a regional educational institution.
4. Have a minimum academic standing of 3.2 cumulative GPA (4.0 scale) or greater (this applies to current students only).

Dependent Scholarship - An applicant must:

1. Be a dependent of a full or part-time Fair Lakes employee, or a dependent of a current Fair Lakes resident (see above listing of applicable Fair Lakes neighborhoods).
2. Be pursuing his/her first undergraduate degree.
3. Be currently enrolled or able to verify acceptance at a college or university for Fall 2007.
4. Have maintained an academic record of 3.2 cumulative GPA (4.0 scale) or greater.

Application Procedures

For consideration for the Year 2008 Fair Lakes Scholarship, you must adhere to the following procedures.

1. Applicant must submit:
 - a) A typewritten application filled in completely.
 - b) A 200 word typed essay describing your career goals & the person or experience that has had the most influence on formulating your goals.
 - c) Your transcript verifying a minimum academic standing of 3.2 cumulative GPA (4.0 scale) or greater (if current student).
 - d) A letter verifying acceptance at a college or university for dependents; or at a regional educational institution for employees.
2. Application packet must be received by the Fair Lakes League by May 16, 2008.
3. Applications that are incomplete will **not** be considered.
4. Last year's recipients are not eligible for the Year 2008 Scholarship.

Judging Procedure

All personal information and employment information will be used for verification purposes only. All applications will be judged on the following criteria: academic achievement, volunteer/civic achievements, essay. In addition, finalists may be judged on interviews. Employment and resident information will be verified for all finalists.
